



The Repository of Industrial Security Incidents is a database of incidents of a cyber security nature that have (or could have) affected process control, industrial automation or Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) systems.

Modeled after similar safety-related incident databases, RISI serves

as an industry-wide repository for collecting, investigating, analyzing, and sharing critical information regarding cyber security incidents that directly affect SCADA, manufacturing, and process control systems. It provides a historical representation of industrial cyber-security incidents from which industry can gain a realistic understanding of the associated risks. It

also provides RISI members with reliable information support for adapting current security policies to reflect the changing dynamics of industrial cyber-security.

RISI Addresses Questions Like

- How urgent is the security risk to control systems?
- What security vulnerabilities are exploited?
- What are the threat sources?
- How serious are the consequences?
- Which industrial cyber-security incidents are fact and which are urban myth?

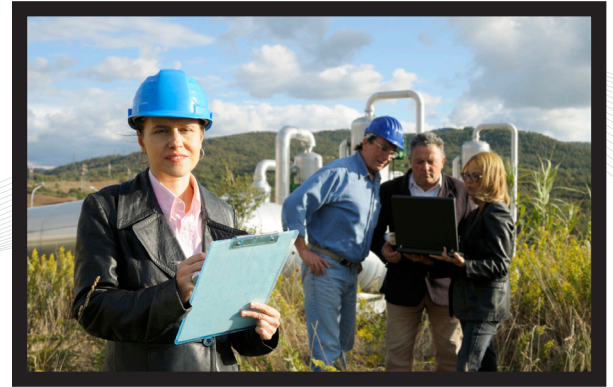
